The Municipal Court Office is also open to the public Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m.-NOON, 1:00 p.m.-5:00 p.m. If you have questions, you can stop by the office or call Shakeenah Coleman (706) 883-2017.

Municipal Court proceedings are being rescheduled to mid-July.

If you have a case that was scheduled for **Tuesday, June 16th or later**, your case has been rescheduled for a later court date to mid-July or later. To check on court dates go to www.lagrangega.org

Court rescheduling dates will be mailed to the last known address on the ticket. If your address has changed since the time you received a traffic citation or other court proceedings, call the court to give them your new mailing address.
