As you may have heard, Gov. Kemp will officially close Georgia's public colleges beginning Wednesday. The Georgia Independent College Association has confirmed, however, that this order does not involve that state's private institutions of higher learning.

LaGrange College will continue the schedule announced Sunday that has instruction suspended until Thursday (when online instruction begins), and has only residence halls, the library, the dining hall and offices remaining open.
